A PRIZE,--- By a gentleman from Galveston we learn that Com. Moore has sent into Galveston a Mexican schooner, captured off Tampico and loaded with Sugar, coffee and silks. When the Commodore's boat was sent to board her, the schooner fired upon it and hoisted the Mexican flag. She was immediately captured, a prize crew put on board and sent into port. She will doubtless be condemned.
