A hurricane occurred at Galveston, Texas, 3d to the 5th Oct., and the following vessels were injured: brig Perseverance, of Baltimore; schr. Select, Cook, of do.; schr. Henry, of do.; and brig Jane, Allen, of New Orleans; all driven ashore, high and dry. Brig Elbe, of New-York, dismantled, a perfect wreck; Tex. schr. Brutus, a total loss; schr. Correo, ashore; Tex. schr. Star, do.; Tex. schr. Tom Toby, foundered; schr. Fourth of July, ashore; besides several schooners ashore, names not known.
