AUG. 25, 1837—The Brutus and Invincible arrive off the bar at Galveston with a Mexican schooner in tow, captured near the Banks of Campeachy. The Brutus enters the harbor with the prize; but the Invincible, not being able to get in, is attacked the following day by two of the enemy's armed brigs, and on attempting to retreat, strikes on the breakers near the southeast channel and goes to pieces. The crews are safely landed.
